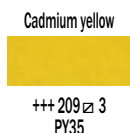

degree of lightfastness

- +++ = at least 100 years lightfast under museum conditions (113 colours)
 - ++ = 25 - 100 years lightfast under museum conditions (5 colours)
 - + = 10 - 25 years lightfast under museum conditions (2 colours)
 - ° = 0 - 10 years lightfast under museum conditions
- The lightfastness of all these colours has been tested in accordance with ASTM Standards D4303

209 = colour number
